From points South and West: Take 1-90 East (NYS Thruway) to Exit 51 West-Route 33. Stay on Route 33 to the Grider Street exit (approx. 3 miles). Get off at the Grider Street exit and go straight at the stop sign. At the traffic signal, turn left onto Grider Street. The hospital is the on the right-hand side.  
Use drives 3 or 4 for Visitor Parking.

Use drives 3 or 4 for Visitor Parking.

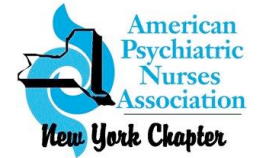
