The breast health mobile clinic is equipped with two state-of-the-art, full-field digital mammography systems. This advanced technology is fast, accurate, and provides exceptional image quality. Two certified mammography technologists are available to conduct your mammogram procedure and your mammogram will be read by a board certified radiologist specializing in women's imaging. Dr. Vivian L. Lindfield, an American Board-Certified Surgeon, specializing in the treatment of breast disease, is the clinical director of the mobile clinic and will oversee and manage the care of each patient.

Since ECMC Foundation's Mobile Mammography Unit was launched in 2012:

- **13,000+** women have been screened on the coach
- **29** women with positive breast cancer results reported
- **1,200+** women were identified as needing additional diagnostic imaging and case management after coach screening
