## CONTINUED STRONG GROWTH

- **General Surgeries** (Inpatient and Outpatient Procedures) **increased by 26%** from 9,159 cases in 2010 to 11,555 cases in 2020
- **Emergency Department (ED)** Volume **increased by 12%** from 58,090 visits in 2010 to 65,180 visits in 2020
- **Total Inpatients** **increased by 27%** from 15,007 patients in 2010 to 19,110 patients in 2020

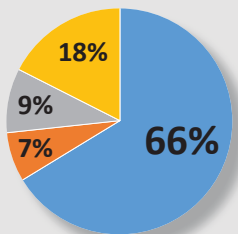

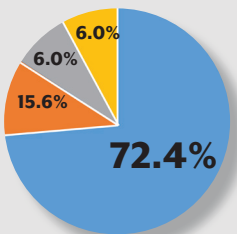
