VI. <u>Reports from the Corporation's Leadership Team</u>

Chief Executive Officer and President

Dr. Quatroche began by acknowledging and thanking Karen Ziemianski and Keith Lukasik for the service over the years. Dr. Thomas Quatroche reported that the hospital received Level 1 Trauma verification from the American College of Surgeons with zero deficiencies found; the hospital also did well on the Joint Commission Opioid Treatment Program Survey and the NYS Pharmacy Board survey. Patient safety indicators reflected a mostly positive month on the journey to zero harm and high reliability. Human experience scores are on par with the statewide benchmark.

Dr. Quatroche reported on events that honored employees during the last month and announced Foundation events to look forward to. Additionally, he reported that there have been 246 new hires in 2022 and that recruiting efforts continue to be very robust. A new administrator has been hired for Terrace View. Reports were given about digital health efforts, PowerShare, HANYS Advocacy Day and a grant received by the BRAVE program here at the hospital.

Chief Financial Officer

A summary of the preliminary financial results through February 28, 2022 was briefly reviewed and the full set of these materials are received and filed. Jonathan Swiatkowski included an update on the financial impact of COVID-19 and funding relief efforts.

Resolution Approving Emergency Room Repair Work

Approved March 22, 2022

WHEREAS, Erie County Medical Center Corporation (the "Corporation") recently developed and constructed a new Emergency Department (the "Project"), utilizing the Pike Company ("Pike") as construction manager to manage or perform all work related to the Project;

WHEREAS, a sprinkler line burst and caused significant flooding throughout a portion of the Emergency Department;

WHEREAS, although the water was immediately removed, the flooding caused significant damage within the Emergency Department;

WHEREAS, such damage must be remediated immediately to prevent mold and mildew from forming, to ensure the ongoing health and safety of other patients within the Emergency Department, and to ensure the Emergency Department is operating at full capacity to meet the urgent needs of its patient population;

WHEREAS, New York State law and the Corporation's Procurement Guidelines permit emergency procurements in the event of an immediate threat to public health, welfare, or safety;

WHEREAS, such emergency procurements are limited to those supplies, services, or items necessary to meet the immediate emergency; must be made with such competition as is practicable under the circumstances; require approval of the Corporation Chief Executive Officer when practicable; and require ratification by the Corporation Board of Directors if the projected cost is in excess of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000);

WHEREAS, the Corporation has determined it is in its best interest to engage Pike to perform the remediation services due to its expertise and familiarity with the Project and the affected areas of the hospital, ensuring the swiftest remediation and return of the Emergency Department to full functionality;

WHEREAS, the Chief Executive Officer of the Corporation has approved this procurement on an emergency basis necessary to meet the immediate needs of the Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the facts and circumstances and has determined that this emergency procurement is necessary due to the immediate threat posed to public health, welfare or safety;

Now, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors resolves as follows:

1. The Corporation is hereby directed to authorize engage Pike on an emergency to perform the Emergency Department remediation work outlined herein.

2. The Corporation is authorized to take all steps necessary to effect this procurement in accordance with this resolution, New York State law, and the Corporation's Procurement Guidelines.

3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
