

Mental Health Services Policy

Access to appropriate and confidential counseling and medical and mental health services is ensured for all residents. Notification of Program Directors or Department Chairman will occur only at the specific request of the resident seeking these services.

Charges for services are determined by individual providers. Coverage for these services is outlined in the summary plan description for the University Dental Resident Services, P.C. Medical and Dental Plan.

Residents may obtain a listing of participating psychiatrists, psychologists, and addiction counselors from their health insurance provider.
